PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the period 1 to 18 March 1969 the Battalion continued land clearing operations east of An Hoa in the Phu Nhuans while providing one company for security of a portion of Liberty Road between An Hoa and Phu Lac (6). The Battalion utilized TD-18 bulldozers and an Eimco tractor with a romo plow in clearing treelines, trenchlines and fortifications. Contact with the enemy was light throughout this period but numerous surprise firing devices were encountered. On 19 March the Battalion crossed the Song Thu Bon River and commenced search and clear operations moving west in the Arizona area. The Battalion encountered light enemy contact in the Arizona area from 19 to 26 March. From 27 to 31 March the Battalion encountered sizable VC/NVA forces well dug in with automatic weapons and mortar capabilities.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTINGS OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

A. TOPICS1. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

a. Strength. The Battalion strength at the beginning of the month was 38 officers and 1,161 enlisted. By the end of March, the strength was 39 officers 1,137 enlisted. The Battalion joined 14 officers and 158 enlisted men during the month. Eight officers and 174 enlisted men were transferred. Casualties sustained by the Battalion during the month were as follows:

b. Discipline, Law and Order. During the month six men were confined in the III MAF Brig, four of whom were confined as the result of previous courts-martial. The other two are awaiting courts-martial and are in pre-trial confinement status. There are five article 32 pre-trial investigations, one General Court, two Special Courts, and two Summary Courts-Martial pending for the month. The new JAG Manual investigations for the month are as follows: one motor vehicle accident, one accidental death, two missing personal effects and one accidental discharge.

c. Postal. Mail for the month of March has been normal.

d. Awards. There were one Silver Star Medal, five Bronze Star Medals, four Navy Commendations Medals, and two Navy Achievement Medals received and presented with appropriate ceremony during the month. Eleven awards were readdressed and forwarded to former members of this command. During this same period 79 U. S. Awards for heroism and meritorious service, and one award of the Vietnamese Medal of Honor, first class, were processed by the Battalion.

2. Intelligence.

a. Enemy. During the month of March there were 56 enemy contacts, 32 of which were initiated by the enemy. From 1 to 26 March the contacts were sniper and harrassing type incidents. The enemy relied heavily upon the use of surprise firing devices instead of contact by fire. On three occasions rifle companies received mortar fire in their night defensive positions. During the period 27-31 March the Battalion encountered sizable VC/NVA Forces in the Arizona area North of An Hoa.

Intelligence sources indicated that elements of the Q83 NVA were operating in the area of AT8652 and the 1st VC in the areas of AT8955 and AT9059. The largest number of URS reported were located in the southwestern sector of Base Area 112.

b. Weather. The temperature during the month of March ranged from a high of 90° to a low of 71°. Very little precipitation was received during this period.

c. Terrain. The Battalion Area of Operations consisted of rice paddies with small areas of high ground covered with shrubs and treelines. These breaks in terrain afforded the enemy camouflage and concealment, and prevented detection by either ground troops or aerial observation.

3. Organization and Operations.

a. Organization. The organization of the Battalion consisted of the following parent unit being detached during March:

Company H, 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines OPCON to 5th Marines from 010001H to 061200H March 1969.

b. Operations. During the period 1 to 8 March the Battalion continued participation in Operation TAYLOR COMMON. From 9 to 18 March the Battalion conducted search and destroy operations in the Duc Duc District east of An Hoa. On 19 March the Battalion moved northwest of An Hoa within Duc Duc District and continued search and destroy operations for the remainder of the month.

c. Supporting Arms.

(1) Air Support.

(a) Tactical Air Support. A total of 33 tactical air support missions were flown in support of the Battalion consisting of 54 sorties. Of these flights, 21 were controlled by an AO, 6 were controlled by the Battalion ALO, and 6 were controlled by means of an A6A Beacon.

(b) Medical Evacuations. The Battalion requested and received 27 missions consisting of 34 emergency, 32 priority and 24 routine medical evacuations.

(2) Fire Support.

(a) Supporting Elements. During the month of March, the Battalion was supported by Batteries D and E and W Mortar Battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, and Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines.

(1) Significant Fire Support Events. Overall fire support during the month of March was very good. The Battalion requested and received numerous preparation fires which proved to be effective in aiding the Battalion's movement through heavily booby trapped areas.

(3) Engineers. On 7, 8 and 16 March, Support Company, 1st Engineer Battalion was in direct support of the Battalion. The TD-18 bulldozers and a tractor with Eimco roma plow proved to be extremely useful in clearing treelines, trenchlines and fortifications.

(4) Amtracs. During the period 1 to 19 March 4th Platoon, Company A, 3rd Amtrac Battalion was in direct support of the Battalion. The LVT's were used for transporting troops and resupply and were also utilized to retrograde excess equipment, increasing the mobility of the companies.

(5) Tanks. The 2nd Platoon, Company B, 1st Tank Battalion was in direct support of the Battalion during the period 1 to 18 March 1969. The tanks were employed to escort resupply convoys and were very effective in close support for rifle companies on the offensive.

4. Training.

During the month of March, 217 Marines were processed through indoctrination training prior to their deployment to the field.

5. Logistics.

During the period 1 to 8 March all resupply was made by truck convoy from the An Hoa Combat Base. From 9 to 31 March resupply was made by helicopter from the LSA at An Hoa with the exception of one company and the 81 Platoon being resupplied by truck from 8 to 19 March. There were no logistical problems encountered during the month of March.

6. Supply.

During the month of March, four M-60 machineguns, two 81mm mortar tubes and two base plates were received as replacement for dead-lined equipment. The Battalion received one eleven inch typewriter and one manual embosser. One hundred and twenty-five flak jackets were received, temporarily relieving the critical shortage that existed in the Battalion. Sixty-four wrist watches were received on a year old document. This has been a critical logistics summary item since December 1968.

7. Motor Transport.

During the month of March the Motor Transport section completed construction of a lubrication rack.

One M-37 truck with trailer and two M-151A1 trucks were sent to 5th Marines Rear for use.

During the month, ten Marines completed a two day drivers orientation course and were issued operator's permits.

8. Medical.

The Battalion Aid Station consisted of two Medical Officers, one Chief Petty Officer and fifteen Hospital Corpsmen. One Medical Officer and three Hospital Corpsmen supported the Command Group in the field. Rifle companies maintained seven to eight Hospital Corpsmen.

Twelve cases of malaria were treated for this Battalion at the BAS.

Thirteen cases of venereal disease were seen this month. Eleven were gonorrhea, one was syphilis and one was chancroid.

A medical bunker was constructed at the Battalion Aid Station.

9. Communications.

During the month of March, field communications continued to be reliable with some friendly interference.

The PRC-77 and KY-38 for voice security continued to be reliable. However, over a period of time the module which controls signal output becomes weak, and consequently, the transmission and reception is gradually becoming weaker. Because of the lack of replacement modules available for the PRC-77, no corrective action can be taken.

PRC-88's were issued to Company H on 20 March 1969 with favorable reactions noted from small unit leaders. The PRC-88 has a maximum range of $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Battery life of the transmitter unit is initially at three days and is likely to pose a logistics problem.

10. Civic Action.

During the month of March an election was held in Xuyen Thu Village, with excellent participation. The Vietnamese continued to be very receptive and cooperative in improving their communities. In Phu Da 2, 34 homes were repaired, three new homes constructed and plans are being considered for a new school. Two new wells were completed in Phu Da 1.

A road was constructed between Phu Da 1 and Phu Da 2 capable of vehicle traffic.

The Civic Affairs Officer presented a total of 15,000 VN\$ from the General Walt Scholarship fund to the parents of 30 children attending the An Hoa complex and Phu Da schools.

Three Vietnamese children were examined by the Battalion Doctor. A 13 year old boy from Phu Da 1 was found to have cataracts covering the retina since infancy. A 12 year old girl from Phu Da 2 received ointment and vitamins for a skin ailment around her mouth. A 5 year old boy from Thanh My hospital was diagnosed as having undescended testicles and an enlarged spleen. Contact has been made with military hospitals in DaNang for further examinations and possible surgery.

11. Psychological Operations.

During the month of March leaflets and posters were distributed to the Vietnamese people in Phu Da 1 and Phu Da 2. From the period of 26-31 March leaflet drops were made in a 4x4 grid area each day.
