(1) Catholic Services. A total of five Sunday Masses were conducted for 2/5 at An Hoa. The chaplain also held 14 masses for the Regiment and attached units. Total attendance was 228 and 196 received communion.

(2) Protestant Services. Four Protestant Services were held for 2/5 at An Hoa by the Regimental Chaplain.

b. Weekday Services

(1) Catholic Services. A total of 33 weekday services were held for 2/5 at An Hoa and for the companies in the field. A total of 390 attended and 244 received communion.

c. Red Cross Cases. During the month of July, eight cases were referred to the Red Cross for action.

d. Counseling Interviews. The 2/5 chaplain interviewed 26 Marines during the month.

e. Memorial Services. During the month of July, one memorial service was held.

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Activities for July 1970 continued at a very low level. The Battalion continued to provide security for Liberty Road and Liberty Bridge Combat Outpost. Company size Reconnaissance in Force operations were conducted in the Arizona, Phu Nhuans, Go Noi and Le Bac Island areas. Contacts and sightings decreased during the month as compared to the previous period with a resulting decrease in fire missions called. Battalion (-) cordon and search operations were again employed with good results. In addition, a number of tank/infantry operations were conducted with considerable success. Casualties during the month were due largely to mines and boobytraps. Preventive measures for countering mines and boobytraps were continuously emphasized to combat the persistent mine and boobytrap threat.

On 4 July, while on a daytime patrol, a platoon from Echo Company made contact with two VC/NVA killing them with small arms. Documents taken from the pack of one VC/NVA identified him as an autonomous chairman.

On 12 July, at 2315H Phu Loc (6) Refugee Compound received one 250 pound lob bomb which resulted in five civilians killed, and fifteen wounded. On 13 July, Hotel Company received a 250 pound lob bomb outside its perimeter. It caused negative casualties.

From 14 - 16 July, 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines (-) (Rein) with maneuver elements consisting of Company's Golf and Fox controlled by the jump Command Post, conducted a cordon and search of the Le Nam (1) area of the eastern area of operations. Company Golf moved overland into cordon positions north of Le Nam (1) just prior to first light, while Company Fox and the jump Command Post helolifted into cordon positions to the south. Fox Company took fire from its east and west flanks when entering the zone. The VC/NVA observed the landing to their south and immediately began fleeing north into Golf Company's blocking positions. Golf Company killed five and captured one. Fox Company killed one. One AK-47 and one .38 caliber pistol were captured along with packs and assorted medical gear. Additionally CIT and ITT processed one hundred Vietnamese National residents of Le Nam (1) and (2) and detained one male and three females as VCI.

On 14 July, while on a morning patrol, a unit from Company Echo found and destroyed three boobytraps: two 81mm illumination canisters with tripwire devices and a 40 pound box mine set in a tank trail with pressure device.

On 18 and 19 July, a company cordon and search operation by Company Golf reinforced with an S-2 search team was conducted in the Tau Phuoc area of the eastern Arizona. A diversionary air strike was conducted north of the target area to drive the enemy south to their harbor sites. Immediately after the strike Company Golf and the S-2 Team were lifted into cordon positions west of Tau Phuoc (2) and (3). Fox Company maintained blocking positions east of the Tinh Yen River. When the cordon was completed, a detailed search resulted in three VC/NVA KIA's and two detainees being taken during the morning hours. That night Company Golf ambushed two separate enemy units attempting to escape the cordon, resulting in two VC/NVA KIA's. Captured weapons, ordnance and other gear included one AK-47, one SKS, three M-26 grenades and one Chinese Communist grenade and two VC/NVA packs with assorted clothing.

On 21 and 22 July, a tank/infantry operation was conducted in the Phu Nhuan by Company Fox and Company Golf and a platoon from Charlie Company, 1st Tank Battalion. After Fox Company received approximately 300 rounds of small arms and automatic weapons fire from an unknown sized

enemy force, Golf Company reinforced with one platoon of tanks responded by driving west from Liberty Road. Fox and Golf Companies coordinated and assaulted the hamlet area from which the fire was received but the enemy had fled. A detailed search of the tree-lines resulted in the capture of two NVA nurses and one NVA Lieutenant who were hiding in a spider hole. Later, Golf Company received fire from a tree-line from the north and responded with small arms and tank fire. A sweep of the area produced two VC KIA. Three more VC were spotted and one was killed. The next day as the sweep continued, Fox Company captured three VC/NVA in a tree-line, one of which was seriously wounded and died shortly after capture. Weapons, ordnance and equipment captured included one AK-47, two .38 caliber pistols, four M-26 grenades, two chicon grenades, one U. S. Compass, assorted medical supplies and various packs.

From 24 - 25 July, 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines (-) (Rein) participated in operation "Barren Green". Maneuver elements from the 5th Marines consisting of Company Fox, Company Golf and Company India were controlled by the Battalion jump Command Post. A cordon and search of the My Hoip area of the Northern Arizona was conducted at first light when the companies were lifted into three zones around the village. Negative fire was received upon entering the landing zones. Shortly after insertion, the cordon was completed and a detailed search commenced. It appeared that the enemy had been forewarned of the operation; however, positive results were achieved. Three VC/NVA were taken from spider holes and one other male was found and detained. The Pacificer Company which was also OPCON to 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines, was inserted west of the cordon and accounted for two VC/NVA KIA's. A total of 10,000 pounds of corn was destroyed. Weapons, ordnance and gear captured consisted of four AK-47's, two M-26 grenades, eleven Chinese Communist grenades, and assorted uniforms and documents. Additionally 70 Vietnamese Nationals were screened by IIT and CIT and 47 bunkers were destroyed.

On 29 July, 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines (-) (Rein) with maneuver elements consisting of Company Fox and Company Golf controlled by the Battalion jump Command Post conducted a cordon and search operation of the Tan My, Phu Phong area of the Northern Arizona. The Battalion varied previous tactics by lifting into the zone in mid-afternoon and quickly cordoned the area. Finding the area only lightly inhabited, the Battalion made a night move on the 31st into a cordon around Nam An (1). Intensive search efforts in the early morning hours resulted in two VC captured along with a .38 caliber pistol and assorted documents. One VC admitted to being head of the Farmers Association and the other to being a ~~force~~ cadre. At mid-afternoon, following a gunship and fixed wing prep, the Battalion was helolifted from the Arizona area into the Cu Ban (6) and An Tan (2) areas of the eastern area of operations. The C&S aircraft and cobra gunships accounted for six VC/NVA KIA. Immediately after the air prep, the units were landed in their respective zones and quickly deployed. Golf Company had light contact and detained one male. Fox Company captured two SKS rifles and detained three females of

military age. On 1 August the search efforts continued.

A. REPORTS

1. Personnel and Administration

a. Strength. The Battalion strength at the beginning of July was 33 officers and 1046 enlisted. At the end of the month, the strength was 33 officers and 1110 enlisted. During the month, the Battalion joined nine officers and 232 enlisted and dropped nine officers and 168 enlisted from the rolls. Casualties sustained by the Battalion during the month of July were as follows:

b. Discipline, Law and Order. During the month, the Battalion Legal Officer processed six Special Courts Martial, 18 Battalion Office Hours and 13 Company Office Hours. At the end of the period there were six Special Courts Martial pending, seven Marines on Legal Hold and four Marines confined in the III MAF Brig. One Marine was declared as a deserter and two are presently U. A.

c. Postal. The Battalion Mail Room has satisfactorily passed all inspections during the month of July. No problems were experienced involving mail delivery during the month.

d. Awards. The Battalion processed 22 awards consisting of five Bronze Stars, two Navy and Marine Corps Medals, six Navy Commendation Medals. A total of 15 awards were received and eight presented while seven were roaddressed and forwarded to the individual's new duty station.

2. Intelligence

a. Enemy. During the reporting period, there were fourteen enemy initiated contacts and thirty-four friendly initiated contacts. Enemy contacts have been light and scattered with their main concern primarily logistical and reconnaissance activity, along with harvesting crops and gathering food stuffs. During the month four different Battalion Operations were held, each lasting about two to three days. Overall, success was experienced by initiating surprise attacks on areas known to be heavily populated with VC/NVA and or enemy sympathizers. The capture of several enemy has further aided in identifying the locations of enemy units in the A. O. A recent Ho Chi Chauh stated that the 91st Support Battalion sends approximately 20 men down from the mountain areas

three times monthly and across Liberty Road between grids AT909490 and AT928521 into the Phu Nhuan to harvest crops and bring the food stuffs back to the mountain base camps. Other intelligence stated that the 38th NVA Regiment, operating out of the mountain area to the west, moves through the Southwestern Arizona to the Northern Arizona, collects food-stuffs, and then returns to its base area. The friendly initiated contacts for the most part were with small groups of two to six enemy. The enemy presently residing in the A. O. are primarily local VC guerrillas.

b. Weather. Comparing this month to last month, rainfall has slightly decreased. The average daytime temperature for the month was 95 degrees and the average low of 78 degrees was experienced during the hours of darkness. The weather did not constitute problems for the tactical maneuver of the Battalion.

c. Terrain. The terrain encountered in the A. O. for the reporting period was primarily lowland rice paddies with patches of high ground covered with treelines and bushes.

3. Organization and Operations

a. The following units were attached or detached during the month of July.

(1) From 8 to 10 July Echo Company provided one squad to the 1st Reconnaissance Battalion on Hill 119.

(2) On 10 and 11 July Echo Company was the Regimental Reserve.

(3) On 12, 13, 25, 26 and 28 July Foxtrot Company was the Regimental Reserve.

(4) On 23 July Golf Company was the Regimental Reserve.

(5) On 24 July India Company, 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines was OPCON to 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines.

(6) On 25 and 26 July Golf Company was OPCON to 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines.

(7) On 1 and 2 July an Armed Propaganda Team was attached to 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines.

(8) On 1, 2, 14, 15, 24, 29 and 30 July an ITT Team and a VET Team were attached to 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines.

(9) On 24 July a Pacifier unit from 1st Battalion, 5th Marines was OPCON to 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines.

(10) During the month of July numerous Tank operations employing a platoon from Charlie Company, 1st Tank Battalion, were conducted in the Phu Nhuan and Arizona areas.

b. Supporting Arms

(1) Tactical Air Support. Air operations for the Battalion included a total of 16 close air support missions. Helicopter gunships and aerial observer aircraft supported the Battalion on numerous occasions. Over 2,700 meters of trolley were destroyed along with 20 structures. A total of 131 bombs, totaling 60 tons of ordnance, were dropped on targets and resulted in 11 secondary explosions. Thirteen beacon flights were conducted during the month.

(2) Helicopter Support. A total of 42 Marine casualties were evacuated during the month. The average time for emergency evacuation helicopters to arrive was 25 minutes. Priority evacuations averaged 32 minutes and routine evacuations averaged one hour and 10 minutes. Nine troop lifts were accomplished during the month.

(3) Artillery and 81mm Mortars. In July, artillery expended 917 rounds on 91 fire missions, while 2,171 rounds were expended on intelligence targets. The 81mm mortars expended 5,549 rounds in direct support of Battalion operations.

4. Schools and Training. During the month of July, 232 Marines attended Indoctrination Training. General Military Subjects Training was conducted every Saturday afternoon in the Battalion Rear at An Hoa. Rifle companies, when in the Battalion Rear area, took advantage of low activity periods for further training and indoctrination. Training was conducted in the following subject areas:

5. Logistics

a. General. During the past month emphasis continued on embarkation readiness in anticipation of future moves. The Battalion attained the highest percentage of equipment readiness (93%) and equipment on hand (99%) to date.

b. Administration. There were no administrative problems during the month.

c. Cantonment Structures. No major construction was required this month and all normal maintenance was accomplished. The Battalion experienced some decrease in engineer and SocBec support.

d. Mess Operations and Facilities. Late in the month the mess hall commenced a program of providing hot meals to Liberty Bridge. To date one run has been made with no exceptional problems encountered.

e. Transportation. The deadline rate continued to improve throughout the month. The only problem experienced was a continued lack of second echelon repair parts for the M274.

f. Supply. Battalion supply nearly completed the retrograde of all unserviceable/excess gear to FLC. During the month, supply turned in all M-14 rifles and accessories to FLC.

g. Medical. The BAS remained located at the An Hoa Combat Base during this reporting period. No major changes were made in the physical facilities of the BAS. Present strength of the BAS is one Medical Officer and 43 hospital corpsmen.

h. Malaria: Five (5) cases were reported.

- c. Heat Casualties: Twelve cases were reported.
- d. Rabies: No cases were reported.
- e. Routine Medical Complaints. Dermatitis - 78, Gastroenteritis - 46, Orthopedic - 20, Ear Disorders - 28, Cellulitis - 37, Eye Disorders - 7, FUO - 8, Miscellaneous Disorders - 308, URI - 14.
- f. Statistics. A total number of 926 patients were seen for an average of 31 per day.

7. Communications

a. Radio Transmission. Implementation of the AKAC-801 wheel code has further reduced communication security violations. Wheel codes are available down to squad level and have made encoding both quick and easy.

8. Civic Action. All civic action operations are conducted by the Regimental S-5.

9. Statistics for the period

- a. Through contacts and fire missions 32 VC/NVA were killed.
